This scholarship is intended to help students of under-served populations to attend Seattle Shakespeare Company's Camp Bill summer camps. By our definition, "under-served" refers to any student who may have faced financial, cultural, or other life circumstance barriers in their lives that could make attending a Shakespeare summer camp challenging.

This scholarship will provide partial or full tuition for the camp of your choice. The application requires a short letter nominating the student for the scholarship, written by either a teacher or other adult who knows the student and thinks they would be a good fit for the camp. Nomination can also be by the student themselves as a self-nomination letter.

Students who are awarded a scholarship are expected to attend the program daily and participate fully.
